How many submissions are allowed per user for the competition?

There is no cap on the number of submissions. A user can work on and submit as many ongoing manuscripts and/or stories that they want, and these can be simultaneous too.

What is the format of the competition like?

The format of the competition is reflective of the nature of the MageQuill creative writing platform. We work with developing and building on ideas, and our focus is on the process rather than the finished product. We aim to assist writers in their journey towards publication. For the competition, we don't expect participants to submit finished stories. You can keep working on them alongside your peers and mentors even after you have shared your entries on the Competition Wall. We will help you shape your entries and ideas on MageQuill and to build on them. You can also work on more than one entry for the competition. There are no word limits or restrictions on the form your story can take. We only ask for the entries to be written in English.

What kind of submissions would you be expecting for the competition?

Your submission(s) can take any form – from a list of points to an explanation of a language system you just made up. There is no cap on the number of words or submissions, and no limit on the form and content. We are all about shedding restraints and writing freely. Please refer to the Competition PDF.
